

National Flight Academy – Facilitator 2, Operations Officer (OpsO), JOC Instructor

Anticipated Seasonal Work Timeline: Summer 2022, Fall 2022, Winter 2022, Spring 2023

Pay: Hourly

Job Requirements: Teaching, Aviation, or Military experience required; Teaching experience preferred; Must be able to pass a level two background screening; Must have a valid driver's license or state issued ID card. Health Information and Portability Act (HIPAA) certified (provided). Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) Identifying and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect certified (provided).

Job Description: JOC Facilitators will serve as the Operations Officer in simulated mission settings for the National Flight Academy (NFA). This position will require roleplay as a US Naval Operations Officer (OpsO) in the Joint Operations Center (JOC). The OpsO will be responsible for preflight briefs, overseeing each simulated mission in real time, and other duties as assigned.

The OpsO will work with an average of 36 students in 3 rotations of 12 students several times a day. Each mission will be precluded by a mission briefing and then monitored via radar control in the JOC. The OpsO will facilitate each mission, from briefing and aircraft assignment through the end of the assigned mission time. OpsO will be responsible for assisting the students with communications protocol and inflight navigation along with completing assigned mission objectives.

Work Environment: The work location is the National Flight Academy facility on Pensacola Naval Air Station, Pensacola, FL. The employee will be required to work primarily indoors in dimly-lit, air conditioned settings in an educational-gaming/ classroom environment. Work will include long periods of computer screen monitoring and use of technology resources.
